

#### WHEN DID YOU LEARN TO DRIVE?

I passed my test 40 years ago on 11-07-67! Just 2 months after my 17th birthday. I was still at school!"

#### WHAT VEHICLE DID YOU LEARN TO DRIVE IN?

A Standard Pennant. It was two tone. Stirling Moss had one!!!"

#### WHAT WAS YOUR FIRST CAR?

A 1955 803 overhead valve Morris Minor Convertible. I can't remember whether it was a split screen or not. It has a starting handle but had no compression. I remember I put a new maroon hood on it. The body work was light blue and the wings were dark blue. It looked like something 'Noddy' would drive!!!"






#### WHEN DID YOU GET YOUR FIRST JAGUAR AND WHAT WAS IT?

'It was the 1958 XK150 Drop Head Coupe in August 2002."

#### WHAT OTHER JAGUARS DO YOU OWN?

I have a 1995 XIS facelift 4 NL Coupe, 1964 Daimler 2.5 Auto V8, 1976 Series 2 Jaguar XJ 4.2L, 2 door pillar less Coupe and my daily drive is a 1996 X300 3.2L Sovereign. I had no experience of Jaguars before owning the XK150



wanted one as a result of this. A mate of mine (Dennis), who is older than me, has had a XJ12 for the past 3 years. It's about the same age as my Sovereign. It has a 6.0L engine, which is quite rare. He says that Jaguar never made an ugly car, and I have to agree. They do make very good looking cars."

As I work in London, I don't really get the time so I only undertake basic maintenance. I rely on people that know what they are doing. I have a local mechanic who does my routine maintenance but recently I had the




