

<u>To spray or not to spray</u> <u>- some questions answered.</u>

Since the introduction of new legislation, confusion has reigned over the use of cellulose based spray paints and conflicting advice given by paint factors.

These paints are continuing to be made for use on Historic and Classic vehicles, which is unlikely to change for the foreseeable future. However, this message does not appear to have filtered through to a lot of classic owners.

The FBHVC and DEFRA have been in consultation in regard to the issue of licences for restorers to use this paint. Cellulose can still be purchased in shops. If licences are introduced along with specialist equipment, one thing is certain. The costs will be passed on to us, the classic enthusiast.

The jury is still out to lunch and the classic car restorers and owners await their decision.

This is a great social event and aims to get as many different marques as possible, with 200 cars last year. Just turn up and pay for what you eat and drink. Starts approx 7:30pm.






