



MEMBER BUYS A NEW JAGUAR XF

I thought that you would be interested in my new Jaguar Premium XF which I took delivery of on the 18th December 2008. See photographs attached. This is the first time in 18 years that I have gone for a smaller car than the XJ range and the first time ever that I have chosen a diesel power train. I purchase my cars through Stratstone of Blackburn, who are part of Pendragon, as they always treat me 'like a VIP customer' and always take my Jaguars in part exchange (unlike Grange Motors' salesmen who never even attempt to talk to me let alone try to sell me cars!). Having said that the service team of Mick and Steve, headed by Ray Chandler are the most professional people that you could ever meet!! I drove my 4.2 litre petrol XJ8 Sovereign (which had been given a complete valet inside and out - although it didn't need it!) 250 miles to Blackburn, leaving at 4:50 am on the

18th December, arriving at the dealership at 8:30 am, having stopped at the local services after the long trip to wash the car

PETER DAVEY & MARTIN LAKELAND DEALER SALESMAN with water that I took with me together with a bucket, sponge, car wash and a leather (well I couldn't hand it back dirty could II). During this trip I averaged 21.5 miles to the gallon!! I then took delivery of my new Jaguar Premium Luxury XF 2.7 litre diesel and after a couple of hours rest drove home again averaging 36.5 miles to the gallon (now I know why I changed to a diesel). Having driven the vehicle for a couple of weeks now I am very impressed with the room in

(except initially when starting from cold but even then it is quieter than I thought it would be). The power is certainly sufficient not to notice the difference between the 2.7 litre diesel engine and the 4.2 litre petrol engine and the advance in technology is amazing since I purchased my Sovereign from new 20 months ago.
