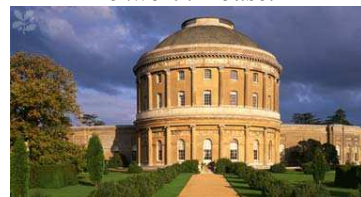
Apparently, this event is being supported by Grange Motors, Fox Garages and the Norfolk region.

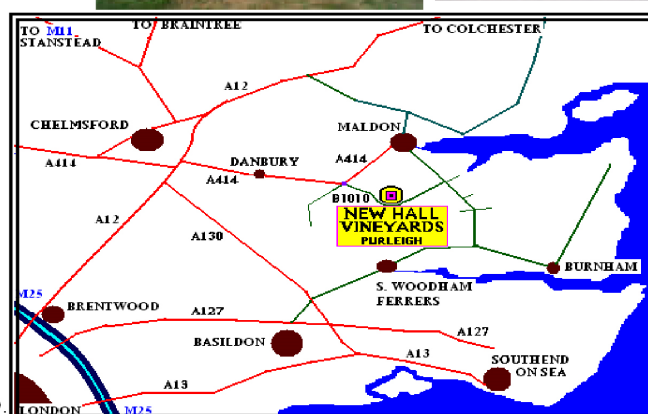

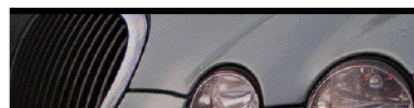
