An extract from an article I read in a classic car rag recently may be of interest to members;

"From a date yet to be announced (expected early 2011) new rules will come into force which will make it illegal to own a vehicle that is taxed for the road but not insured for the road. If you cancel your road insurance or don't renew it, you will have to surrender the tax disc and make a "SORN" declaration. This will apply even if it's a "free" disc.

The only exception to this rule will apply to vehicles that have been continuously unlicensed since before 31 Jan 1998 (which are not covered by SORN until after they are licensed again).

The authorities will be comparing the Tax and Motor Insurance Bureau (MIB) database records and where a vehicle appears to be uninsured, but taxed, a warning letter will be sent which if ignored will generate an automatic fine".

Members who plan taking their cars off the road for a while, during which their insurance ends, will need to watch this.




