

A car parade will finish the day's events and will feature a selection of vintage, classic and modern cars in action as they take part in a parade around the grounds. County Councillor Jeremy Lucas, Cabinet Member for Environment and Culture, said: "The Essex County Car and Motorcycle Show is one of the highlights of my year. It's brimming with all the things a motor show should have, with more than 200 cars to see. "With cars, entertainment and shows for adults and interactive activities for the children, this event promises to be a great day out for the whole family." Della Nixon, Events and Booking Officer at Cressing Temple, said: "We have an exceptional line-up this year from rare vintage cars, to a replica of the Silver bird. 
