

MEMBER'S STORY



TOURING SCOTLAND, OLD STYLE.

After heat waves this Easter and every spring for the last few years. I really did believe the official statistic that April is the driest month in Scotland, and the best time to tour the highlands of Scotland. Hmmm. Well let's just say that, this year, I certainly avoided the dreaded midges during my adventures through wind, rain and snow in my open top Suffolk SS100!

I built the car 18 months ago and this was to be its first real test; just over 2500 miles, or about 170 miles a day, on A and B roads avoiding motorways, up the west coast of Scotland to Durness



(Cape Wrath), across to John O'Groats and then back down the east coast again. As I'd had no mechanical experience before building it, could I trust my own handiwork?



With AA card and emergency number programmed into my phone, and a small holdall as luggage in the passenger footwell - the SS100 has no boot and only about six inches of room behind the seats - I set off on a Thursday morning after Easter. An early sign of what to expect was when the heavens opened about 30 minutes later, just 9 or 10 miles around the north circular. The rain continued pretty much until the morning of day 3, in the Lake District.

Driving on a small road near the Kirkstone Pass, I experienced my only mechanical issue; reaching the top of a hill I found my throttle stuck wide open and started screaming down the other side, 1 in 4 with hairpin bends. My heart rate almost matched the engine RPM! Thank goodness the Suffolk has disc brakes. It took 30 seconds to

fix - the throttle return spring had simply become unhooked - and, after some photos, I was on my way again. I was punished, however, by an absolute deluge until Stranraer

I had a couple of great days (showery but some sun) driving up through Ayr, Loch Lomond, Oban and Fort William to Arisaig. The Ben Nevis range looked incredible with thick snow down to the tree line, set against green slopes and deep blue lochs. The road to Mallaig has been "improved" but now cuts through everything like a motorway; fortunately the old road still exists as a B road after Arisaig, twisting past fabulous beaches and, in the evening, allowing time to see a spectacular sunset looking across to the western isles.

Next day I took the ferry across to Skye. My plan then had been to drive north to Shieldaig and Ullapool. I'd heard a week or two earlier that, following a landslide, the LochCarron road was closed, with 140-mile diversions to Inverness and back! But luckily, they reopened the road that very morning.

The scenery in Sutherland is perhaps the best of all and the few moments I saw it in sunshine were truly memorable. Sadly, I drove to Durness and past Dounreay to John O'Groats against rain and a 60mph wind so strong that I didn't dare try putting the hood up; be assured the weather reports were optimistic in saying "feels like" 0 degrees!

My adventures down the east coast were colder still, driving through snow and hail; the latter is very painful with

the top down at 40mph. However the scenery through Speyside and Cairngorm - and the malt whisky! - made it worthwhile. So too Northumberland, although thick fog on the moors in the dark, when I couldn't even see the side of the road, was a real challenge.

All in all, though it may not suit many, a real adventure holiday. Both the SS100 and I were weather-beaten but came through it unscathed and with something to be proud of. Would I do it again? Yes! (Although maybe in summer next time...).




