

SUNDAY LUNCH AT THE HARE, ROXWELL, CHELMSFORD.








NEC CLASSIC CAR SHOW 16th to 18th NOVEMBER


JAGUAR FACTORY TOUR

We were taken around by a guide Tony Rollason. Tony is a 79 year old ex-employee who started at the Castle Bromwich factory in the early sixties. He has seen a lot of changes over the years. He described also how when he was a child, he watched the factory build spitfires and used to see them wheel the aircraft across the road (Chester Road) from Gate 1 and onto the airfield opposite. There is now a housing estate opposite. It felt odd to think that opposite the factory was an airfield when you see houses opposite. We toured the factory and saw various XJ being made, as well as the XF. Quite a few XF Sportbrakes were rolling along the production

line destined for all over the world. The pinnacle of the day was two fold. The guide indicated that we would end up at the F-Type production line and that a actor was due in the factory today - Damien Lewis of the Channel 4 program, "Homeland". We did see him being entertained by some Jaguar big wigs in the final factory. He was being introduced to a brand new black XJ. We on the other hand had more important things to look at, *such as the F-Type of which there were at least six models to view!* These were all pre-production models that were destined for assessment. Tony indicated that these would undergo



various tests then be scrapped. What a shame that this has to happen. The car is better looking in the metal than the picture, I can assure you all. We ended the tour by returning to the visitor centre by Gate 1

SUNDAY 18 NOVEMBER 2012, WHAT DOES THIS DATE MEAN?

Are you aware that on this date the regulations changed relating to MoT's and pre 1960 cars? First off, it is stressed that while pre-1960 vehicles will no longer require a compulsory MoT, there has been no legal roadworthiness requirement applicable to these vehicles, or to the obligation on owners to ensure their cars are maintained in a roadworthy condition. In other words, it still has to be capable of passing an MoT, even though it doesn't need to, and you won't be able to get away with an ineffective



handbrake, non-working wipers, and the like, on the basis that the car is MoT exempt. The qualification date, where no date of manufacture is stated on the V5 will be January 7 1960. This date has been chosen as any car registered in the first week of 1960 must have been manufactured in 1959. The majority of



V5Cs record just the date of registration, though in some cases mainly vehicles first used overseas or which were off the road between 1978 and 1984 (and thus missed going onto the DVLA database first time around) - the V5 will include a statement that the vehicle was previously registered and/or used prior to date of registration: declared manufactured 19XX. This will be accepted as evidence of the vehicles age. The procedure for taxing a pre-1960 vehicle will be broadly as now, and on-line applications will simply not include an MoT test check. Applications to retax at a post office or, while they remain open, LVLO will need to be accompanied by a completed V112 "Declaration of Exemption" from MoT Testing form, declaring the vehicle to be exempt from the Mot.
