

Where are you, RGB 43G?

That was the question posed in Gaynor Cauter's S Type Register in August's Jaguar Drivers Magazine. Doug Warren obtained the copy from a JDC member attending the Classic and Sports Car Breakfast Meet at the Hare in Roxwell.

Gracing the page was a period shot of my 420. It turned out that the previous owner, David Edwards, had seen it at a previous gathering in June but was unable to find the current owner. In the article, he goes on to say......

"The car was one of the last 420's off the production line and was

three years old when I bought it from my neighbour. I used it as a daily driver until 1974, after which it was just used for weddings and days out. Losing interest, I stored it in a barn in Mountnessing which subsequently collapsed on it during high winds in the '80's. It suffered some damage to the roof, bonnet and rear wing. With this in mind and since I no longer used the car, I decided to sell it to a buyer in Writtle. [and that's where I came in]"

He recalled that RGB had covered around 85.000 miles when he sold it and had been virtually fault free. The only serious problem was a burnt out valve which occurred when he decided to see how fast it would go. [about 125mph when valve stopped play].

I subsequently contacted Gaynor which lead to my meeting David at the Hare's September gathering. He is still running Jaguars – currently an XJ6 V8. David remembered towing RGB round to my house with his Granada a few days after the sale, and, although surprised I had kept it all that time, he was more surprised with himself for selling it. For that privilege, I had handed over one thousand hard earned green ones, however, to my surprise David had paid only £750 for it.... But it was back in '71, so I'll comfort myself with the thought that there was rampant inflation in the intervening

brand new Escort which stopped unexpectedly at traffic lights. The Ford ended up with a re-styled rear that Henry would not have been proud, but the Jag suffered a minor dent to the chrome radiator grille housing. A scar that it still displays to this day.

Hopefully, all three of us will meet up again in the near future. Until then, I had better get on with some of those jobs I've been putting off from the summer. Now, where's that spanner.....?? *Neil Shanley*







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
