



We have been invited to join the PCGB at M-B World, at Brookland's Drive, Weybridge KT13 0SL, and Brookland's Museum is at Brookland's Road, KT13 0QN.

Admission to M-B World is free and, to allow sufficient time for a look round, we will arrive at 10.00a.m. We have a tour booked for 11.30a.m, which will give us sufficient time to see the Silver Arrow's Stunt Show at midday. 




