

PEBRUARY CLUB MIGHT





"To the Bat Cave Robin....." or not as the case may be as members are invited to take their Jaguars out on Sunday 24th April for "Drive It Day"

Every year 'Drive It Day' is purposefully held on the Sunday nearest to 23 April. Why? Because it commemorates the 64 cars that left London on the first day of the Thousand Mile Trial on 23 April 1900.

The Royal Automobile Club Thousand Mile Trial started in London and passed through Bristol, Birmingham, Manchester - travelled through Scotland - then passed back thorough more English locations until they were back in London again.

The tour lasted until May 12th and 46 out of approximately 65 starting cars made it to the finish line.

There are loads of events happening all over Britain for Drive It Day. Classic car shows, car runs including all types of vehicles from VW campers, motorcycles, military vehicles and cars young and old! It's a day to celebrate and share and display these great motors with other car lovers.

The Directors of the Federation of British Historic Vehicle Clubs (FBHVC) have announced that Drive It DayTM 2016 has been nominated by the Fédération Internationale des Véhicules Anciens (FIVA), the world body governing historic vehicle issues, as its flagship event for the UK marking World Motoring Heritage Year.

World Motoring Heritage Year has been declared during 2016 to mark FIVA's fiftieth anniversary but more importantly to raise awareness of the enormous heritage value that lies in historic vehicles preserved by thousands of enthusiasts around the world. It has long been an ambition of FIVA, and its member national federations, to gain recognition for the heritage value of historic vehicles and marking World Motoring Heritage Year through events held around the globe will be a powerful demonstration of the breadth and depth of enthusiasm for our mobile heritage.

Commenting on the announcement, FBHVC chairman, David Whale said, "This is a fitting recognition of the status of Drive It DayTM. It is truly a people's day with an estimated 250,000 vehicles taking part at events across the country and we are delighted that FIVA have recognised it among the select few events to be granted this accolade".

Therefore, we are off to Chislehurst Caves for a guided tour of the caves. The tour is expected to take up to 50 minutes and will begin at 11:15 prompt. Following the visit we will have a *mystery stop* and then will then go to The Grasshopper at Westerham for a carvery meal at 2pm. It is just 13 miles from the caves. Cost of the carvery is just £12:90pp (limited space). All interested members are to book with Doug Warren in advance. We will meet on the day at Thurrock Services at 10:30am, whereby a convoy of Jaguars will make off across the bridge to Chislehurst. Cost of the tour will be £3:50 for over 60's or £5 for under 60's.

Classic Car Show and Autojumble Sunday May 15th 2016

The Annual Classic Car Show at Battlesbridge is to take place earlier this year on 15th May. The Council's success in stopping a number of events at the "showground" was upheld by the Government Planning Inspector and prevented Jim Gallie from undertaking any more shows or events for more than 28 days a year. Therefore, our regular May and September shows are safe. However, the decision by the Planning Inspector was overturned by the High Court as Jim's legal team took it further. So it has been sent back for a re-assessment. A decision has yet to be made.

So, I am now taking bookings for the May show. The cost is £10:00 for car, driver and one passenger. There is likely to be limited availability, therefore bookings must be made as soon as possible and full cost of the pass to be paid by April 5th 2016 club night.
